In the meantime may we please remind parents of our 'usual' school start and finish times:-

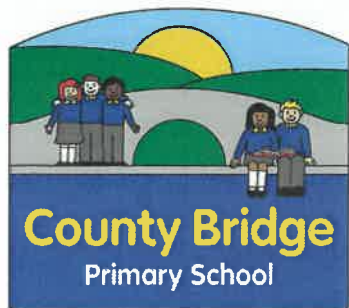
